



- Raises aspirations, provides enjoyment, builds confidence and self-esteem - the curriculum should motivate all pupils to want to come to school, learn and be keen to succeed regardless of their personal, social and family circumstances.

- Encompasses the acquisition of personal, learning and thinking skills - All subjects will emphasise the teaching, learning, assessment and progression in cross curricular skills.
